City sees 8 organ transplants in 24 hours, thanks to 2 cadavers

Mumbai: Eight organ transplants were carried out in the city over the past 24 hours, thanks to two cadaveric donations in hospitals located at two ends of the city on Monday night.

In the first instance, a 58-year-old south Mumbai resident's wife and daughters donated his heart, liver and kidneys after he was declared brain-dead at Sir H N Reliance Hospital in Girgaum. Around the same time, a father and a sister gave consent for four organ donations when a 38-year-old man was declared brain-dead in Wockhardt Hospital in Mira Road. Both families also donated

compared with a total of 58 in 2016, said officials of the Zonal Transplant Coordination Centre (ZTCC), which coordinates and distributes donated organs among hospitals. At the time of going to press, a team from Fortis Hospital in Mulund was in India to receive a donor heart.

organ transplant conducted at Sir H N Reliance Foundation Hospital. The patient had suffered an intracranial bleed," said its medical director Dr Gustad Daver. "A green corridor was created with the support of Mumbai police to transport the heart to Fortis Hospital, Mulund and a liver and kidney to

Global Hospital in Parel," added Dr Daver. One of the kidneys was donated to a patient registered at H N Hospital itself.

Dr Ravi Hirwani, who heads Wockhardt Hospital at Mira Road, said their 38-year-old donor was brought to the hospital on June 3 with a massive brain bleed that was beyond treatment. "Thanks to his family, we carried out our first cadaveric liver transplant. This means that people living in distant suburbs needn't go far to access such life-saving operations," he said. The Mira Road donor's heart was donated to a patient registered at Kokilaben Hospital in Andheri and his kidneys were given to patients registered at Jaslok Hospital at Peddar Road and Seven Hills Hospital in Andheri.

Two cadaver donations save 8 lives

MUMBAI: Two cadaver donations on Monday night saved eight lives in the city on Tuesday, said officials from the Zonal Transplant Coordination Committee.

The total cadaver donation count in the city has touched 23, which is better than the figures recorded last year, said state officials. In 2016, 58 cadaver donations took place.

The donors on Monday were two men aged 57 and 38, who died of intracranial bleeding at Sir HN Reliance Hospital and Research Centre, Grant Road and Wockhardt Hospital, Mira Road. Their families consented to donate their hearts, kidneys, livers and corneas after they were counselled.

The heart from HN Reliance hospital was transplanted into a 62-year-old man from Bandra, who had a fatal heart condition called dilated cardiomyopathy. He had been wait-listed for the transplant for the past three weeks.

Dr Anvay Mulay, who performed the heart transplant, said, "The recipient is stable and under constant observation for the next 48 to 72 hours that are

He added, "It is indeed a proud moment for everyone in Mumbai. The city has responded warmly to the cause of organ donation," he added.

The liver and a kidney were sent to Global Hospital, Parel. The other kidney was transplanted into a patient at the same hospital.

Meanwhile, the heart from

Wockhardt Hospital was sent to Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital and transplanted into a 56-year-old man who was wait-listed on a 'supra urgent' basis.

The kidneys were sent to Jaslok Hospital, Peddar Road, and Seven Hills Hospital, Andheri. The liver was transplanted into a patient at the same hospital.

In another case, at the time of

going to the press, preparations were being made to get a heart from Indore to Mumbai for a transplant procedure at Fortis Hospital.

Dr Gauri Rathod, assistant director at Directorate of Health Services (DHS), said awareness programmes over the past few months have gone a long way towards boosting the state's cadaver donation programme.

2 cadaver donations in a day in Mumbai

Mumbai: The city witnessed two cadaver donations in a day. On Monday night, a 58-year-old man suffered intra-cranial bleeding and was declared brain dead at Sir HN Reliance Hospital. His family agreed to donate his eyes, both kidneys, liver and heart helping save the lives of five others.

According to doctors, while the heart was transported via a green corridor to Fortis Hospital, Mulund, the liver and one kidney was transported to Global hospital through a second green

corridor. One of the kidneys was used for a patient registered at Reliance hospital, and the cornea were donated to an eye bank.

On Monday, another patient was declared brain dead in Mira Road from where doctors retrieved his heart, liver and both kidneys for chronic patients on wait list for a cadaver organ. The deceased, aged 39, was announced brain dead at Pokhara Hospital in Mira Road. Rising awareness on cadaver donations have increased participation of people in organ donation. ENS

MUMBAI SEES 23RD CADAVER DONATION

Mumbai saw its 23rd cadaver donation of the year when a 57-yr-old male was declared brain dead on Tuesday at Sir HN Reliance Foundation Hospital and Research Centre. The family of the deceased consented to donate his heart, liver, kidneys and corneas that went to recipients across different hospitals in the city for which green corridor was created amidst busy office hour traffic.

24 घंटे में 8 को जीवनदान

■ रिपोर्टर, मुंबई : मुंबई में पिछले 24 घंटे में अंगदान के जरिए 8 लोगों को नई जिंदगी की सौगात मिली है। इस अंगदान के साथ ही मुंबई में हार्ट ट्रांसप्लांट की संख्या 56 हो गई है, जबकि इस साल कैंडवर की संख्या 24 पहुंच गई है।

जानकारी के मुताबिक पिछले 24 घंटे में वोक्हार्ट और एचएन रिलायंस फाउंडेशन हॉस्पिटल में दो मरीजों को ब्रेन डेड घोषित कर दिया गया। जिसके बाद अस्पताल और जोनल ट्रांसप्लांट को-ऑर्डिनेशन सेंटर (जेडटीसीसी) द्वारा परिजनों को मरीज का अंगदान करके दूसरों की जिंदगी बचाने का सुझाव दिया गया। जिसे गंभीरता से लेते हुए परिवार वालों ने अंगदान का फैसला लिया। एच.एन. रिलायंस फाउंडेशन हॉस्पिटल में हुए कैंडवर डोनेशन के जरिए हार्ट फोर्टिस, लिवर और एक किडनी ग्लोबल हॉस्पिटल को दिया गया। जबकि दूसरी किडनी हॉस्पिटल के ही एक मरीज को दी गई।

Reliance Foundation Hospital launches cadaver transplants

Mumbai, June 6 (IANS) Mumbai's Sir H.N. Reliance Foundation Hospital on Tuesday joined the ranks of a handful of institutions here offering cadaver transplants by performing a kidney transplant here, an official said.

The family of a 58-year old man, who died due to intra-cranial bleeding, decided to donate his organs like eyes, heart, liver and kidneys to six other needy patients.

Early on Tuesday, medicos at the hospital started the organ grafting procedures and by 10 a.m., they were ready to shift them (the organs) to various hospitals in the city.

With the help of Mumbai police, a green corridor was created to transplant the heart to Fortis, Mulund, and the liver and one kidney to Global Hospital.

The pair of eyes were donated to a city eye bank, while the remaining kidney was transplanted on a patient in hospital itself.

"We are grateful to the family of the patient who took the bold step to donate vital organs and save six lives. We are hopeful that such an act of kindness will inspire more people to come ahead with cadaver donation which can save many lives," the Hospital said.

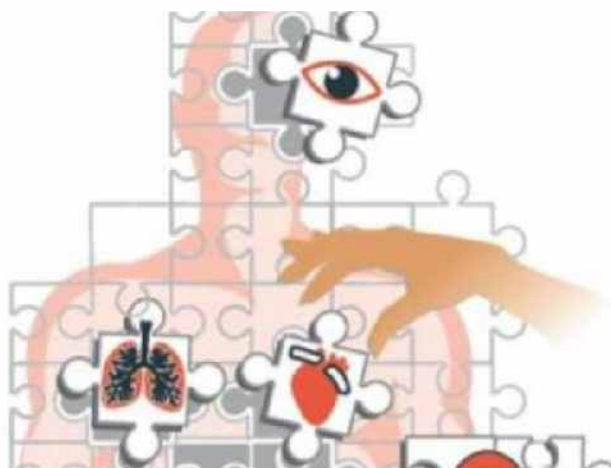

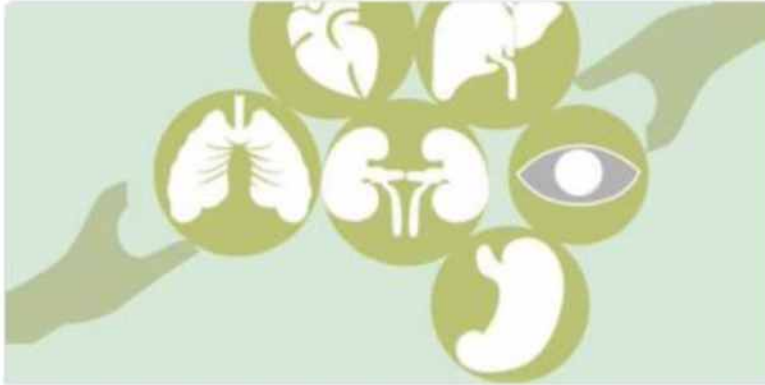

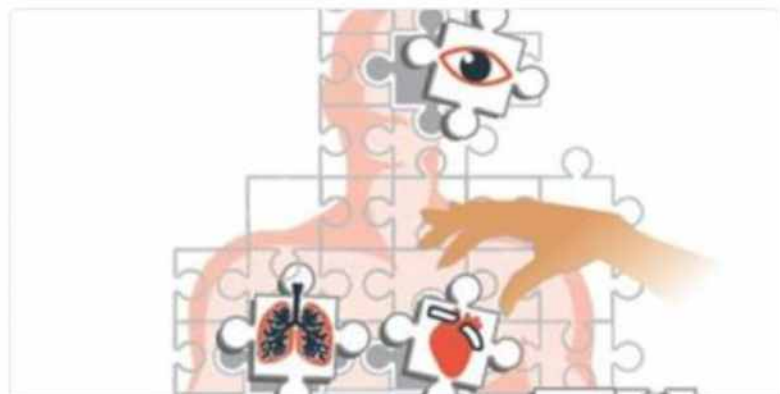
